February 2, 2009—Portsmouth, VA - Hampton Roads #1 rated morning team; WAVY News 10's Kerri Furey, Don Roberts, Cheryl Tan and Meteorologist Jon Cash are expanding their talents to **FOX43 News at 7am**, beginning Monday, February 2nd.

Weekdays at 7am, when WAVY News 10's local coverage gives way to the *NBC Today Show*, local news coverage now continues on WAVY-TV's sister station FOX43 for an additional hour from 7-8am Monday through Friday.

FOX43 News at 7am will provide expanded coverage of news, weather and traffic during the first half hour of the newscast and will evolve into lifestyle news and interviews in the second half hour. This will be the only broadcast local news programming in Hampton Roads during this time.

Kerri Furey and Cheryl Tan will co-anchor **FOX43 News at 7am**, while Don Roberts will provide news content and Jon Cash, weather. Additional feature reports will be contributed by Kelly Gaita – The Face of FOX43.

“A natural extension already exists with our strong WAVY News overnight presence, *SuperDoppler 10 Weather* and *10 Timesaver traffic* dominance delivered by the longest-tenured morning team in the Hampton Roads market,” said WAVY and FOX43 News

Director Kathy Hostetter. “It only makes sense to continue local coverage at 7am for viewers who want an extra hour of local news from their favorite morning team.”
